



## CLASSIC CAR RALLY 2024

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

#### INTERPRETATION OF THESE TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The term 'Delegate' refers to a person attending The Rally
2. The term 'Rally' means the 2024 Classic Car Rally being held in June 2024 at Fareham, based at the Holiday Inn, Fareham, Hampshire.
3. The term 'Event' means a party, dinner, or meeting organised and managed by the organising committee of the Rally.
4. The term 'Booking System' means the system devised by the Organising Committee of the Rally.
5. The term 'Holiday Inn' means the Holiday Inn, Cartwright Drive, Fareham, Hampshire, PO15 5RJ.
6. The term '41club' means The Association of Ex-Round Tablers' Clubs which is a registered not for profit enterprise under GB law.
7. The term '41 Club' means the Association of Ex-Round Tablers' Clubs whose registered address is Marchesi House, 4 Embassy Drive, Edgbaston, West Midlands B15 1TP.
8. The term 'Venue' means a location at which an Event is held.
9. These Terms & Conditions relate only to Events, and do not apply to any accommodation bookings made by the delegate.

#### TICKET DEFINITION

10. All expenses relating to access to locations on the rally and meals not included in the accommodation package are an additional cost.



## BOOKINGS

1. The Booking System will only book your **Rally package**, **Accommodation bookings** must be made separately with the **Holiday Inn** and are subject to the hotel's own Terms & Conditions. Rooms will be allocated on a person-by-person basis. Additional days before and after the weekend must be booked separately and are subject to availability. All bookings made with the hotel are on a private basis and not the responsibility of 41 Club. Hotel rooms must be booked by **March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024**, to receive the special "41 Club Rally Accommodation Package" and payment will be taken at the time of booking. All bookings after this date will be subject to availability and the special rally rate may no longer be available. Delegates are advised to check cancellation details when making a booking and confirm the reservations in writing.
2. Any bookings made after 21<sup>st</sup> May 2024 will be accepted on the basis that we will endeavour to accommodate the entrants' requirements.
3. Bookings are subject to the capacity of each venue.
4. All event bookings are subject to a non-refundable booking fee of £1.

## PAYMENT

1. Payment for all packages must be made in full at the time of booking.
2. It is recommended that Delegates take out travel insurance cover.

## CANCELLATION

1. Cancellation prior to May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, will incur a full refund minus the booking fee. After May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, no refund will be given. Refunds will be made to the card from which the original payment was made.
2. Should an event be cancelled either by the organising committee of the Conference or by a Venue, a full refund will be given minus the booking fee. In the event of postponement, a Delegate may transfer his repayment to any replacement event or receive a full refund.
3. Should a Delegate be unable to travel or attend the rally due to COVID 19 or another serious illness, then he should make a claim via his travel insurance, advising the organisers of the details and outcome. Refunds will not be considered in these circumstances.



### **DELEGATES' RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Delegates must follow any guidelines issued by HM Government regarding the use of masks or social distancing or other safeguarding measures, to prevent the infection of others due to COVID19.
2. All Delegates are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will not cause harm or injury to themselves, others, or damage to property. They must follow directions given by staff marshalling any Event, or Venue management.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any Event if the Delegate is deemed to be unwell, unsafe or in a condition that may be a danger to him/himself or others.
4. The use of Social Media by Delegates should be mindful, non-discriminatory and with the permission of the relevant party.
5. Delegates will be required to pay for the cost of any loss or damage for which they are responsible to any part of the hotel or to any property belonging to or leased by the hotel that has been damaged, destroyed or removed.
6. All participating vehicles must be in a safe and roadworthy condition.
7. All vehicles must be fully insured and taxed along with breakdown cover.
8. Drivers must be fit and well enough to drive their vehicle and ensure they are not under any influence of alcohol or drugs.
9. All routes and instructions will be optional, and entrants may choose not to follow them. This is not a competitive event but purely a social run where the suggested stops are also optional.

### **41 CLUB LIABILITY**

41 Club shall not be liable for any personal injury (fatal or otherwise), or loss and/or damage to persons or property of any nature howsoever caused, sustained by, or occasioned to any person (including persons under the age of 18 years) unless resulting from, or caused by, negligence of 41 Club.

### **DIETARY REQUIREMENTS**

1. We will endeavour to accommodate Delegates' dietary requirements, but these must be clearly specified at the time of booking.



## COMPLAINTS

1. Any complaint must be made in the first instance to the Chairman of the Organising Committee of the Rally (Manny Martins [mandmmartins@btinternet.com](mailto:mandmmartins@btinternet.com)) . If not resolved immediately to the satisfaction of the complainant, the complaint must be placed in writing.
2. The organisers will make every effort to resolve a written complaint as quickly as possible within 14 days of the receipt of the complaint. The decision of the Chairman of the Organising Committee will be final.

These Terms and Conditions do not affect your statutory rights.

The Organising Committee reserve the right to make alterations to these Terms and Conditions without notice.

These Terms and Conditions are subject to the law of England and Wales and to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
